We have been working in the borough of Barnet for over 20 years.



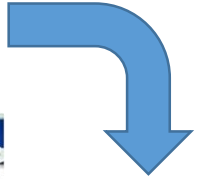
We support people with learning disabilities to speak up about their rights.



We have run self-advocacy groups and meetings so Barnet people with learning disabilities can learn about their rights.

Drop-In groups



We helped co-chair the Barnet Learning Disability Partnership Board as part of the government white paper Valuing People.



We have worked with Barnet Council and the NHS to make sure people with learning disabilities have their voices heard in the services they use.



We campaigned about important issues such as the Changing Places toilets at Finchley Memorial and Barnet hospitals.



We are now running a disability hate crime awareness project to support people with learning disabilities to recognise disability hate crime.



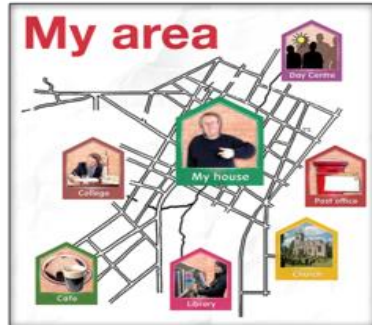
We have trained 300 local police officers in learning disability and disability hate crime awareness.
